RULES OF COMPETITION

Eligibility

- 1. The award is open to persons born in Australia or naturalised Australians permanently residing in Queensland.
- 2. Entrants must be permanent residents of Australia who have resided in Queensland for a minimum of three (3) months immediately prior to nomination, or if resident near a state border can show they are an active working member of their nominating affiliated Agricultural Society.
- 3. Entrants must be aged between 15 and 19 years as at 1st August in the year of the competition.
- 4. The award is opened to both males and females.
- 5. Immediate family members of affiliated Agricultural Societies and QUEENSLAND AG SHOWS committee members and staff are eligible to enter provided they;
- a) Declare a pecuniary interest, and
- b) Are not involved in any discussion regarding the result during the competition.
- 6. The Award seeks to attract all young rural people who symbolise the rural spirit people with vitality, who are forward thinking and with a passion for the land and local Agricultural Shows.
- 7. Entrants should be actively involved, or demonstrate a readiness to become actively involved in, their local Agricultural Society (Pittsworth Show Society) and Agricultural Show (Pittsworth Show Society events). They should also be knowledgeable about current rural issues pertaining to their local area (Pittsworth and the Darling Downs), Queensland and Australia and have a strong affiliation towards agriculture.
- 8. Entrants must accept that any behaviour that will bring disrepute to these Rural Ambassador Awards and is deemed inappropriate by the Pittsworth Show Society Management Committee, prior to or during the competition, may forfeit their right to patriciate and no discussion will be entered into.
- 9. Prizes awarded to Rural Ambassadors are not transferable. All prizes are subject to change without notice and when the prize is a voucher or bursary the voucher and bursary will expire at its expiration date.
- 10. Should an entrant enter and win a prize or title and does not abide by the above conditions, he/she will not be eligible for further participation in the Rural Ambassador Awards and will automatically forfeit all prizes and titles associated with the Rural Ambassador Awards program.
- 11. At Local level, all entries must include a completed entry form, accompanied by a completed questionnaire, recent photograph (in high resolution electronic format). Failure to provide the above documentation will deem the entry invalid.
