All work must be the work of the exhibitor. All quilts must have a 10cm rod pocket for hanging.

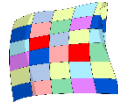
All quilts to have size (width & length) printed on piece of paper pinned to quilt.

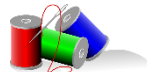
