JUNIOR SECTION

Class 1275 **Any Plant in a container**

Class 1276 **Grass Head JUNIOR SECTION 4-7 YRS AND 8-11 YRS**

Method - Approximately 6weeks prior to the show Sprinkle some grass seeds into the bottom of the stocking foot and fill it with potting mix or sphagnum moss. Twist stocking into shape and size of tennis ball, tie it off leaving about 10cm dangling down at the bottom.

Use an elastic band to make a bulging nose in the stocking face.

Give your grass head a goofy face, glue on googly eyes, pipe cleaners for eyebrows and any decorations you like. Half fill a small container (eg Yoghurt container) with water and place the head on top, so the stocking tail is dangling into the water. Use a spray bottle of water to moisten head. Place on a window sill that gets plenty of sun. use spray bottle daily to keep moist.
