 - Manual entries will be accommodated at the Show Office, and will close at 4PM Monday, 2nd March. **No late entries will be accepted.**
 - Exhibits can be delivered to the Show Office between Monday 23rd February and Monday 2nd March.
 - Refer to each section for specific entry fees and specific delivery dates for your exhibits.
- **Exhibit Delivery to Pavilion (Wednesday, 4th March)**
 - Art exhibits must be delivered by **10:00 AM**.
 - Needlework, Handicraft, Photography, and Pot Plants must be delivered by **3:00 PM**.

All pavilion judging will be completed on **Thursday, 5th March**.

2. All exhibits must be original and completed in previous two years. N.B. Original means works not copies from other artists' work from prints, calendars, post cards or work done at workshops and no computer-generated images.
3. Novice will be for Pittsworth Show entrants only, who have not won a first prize at the Pittsworth Show. Novice must be current year's work, 12 months prior to the show.
4. Entrants will allow TV and Newspaper reproduction of their entry during the show.
5. Any work previously exhibited at the Pittsworth Show will not be accepted. All artists including private showings of work are eligible. The Show Society will exercise reasonable care with works submitted but will not be responsible for any loss or damage whatever, to any works while in their custody.
6. Judge to be asked to judge Champion and remove it from judging sections.
7. Exhibits must have ID cards, obtained from the Show Office, attached to front of painting.
8. Paintings or drawings must be framed or suitably mounted with D-rings cord or wire for hanging.
9. Each entry must be clearly marked on the back with the entrants NAME, ADDRESS, TITLE OF ENTRY, SECTION, and CLASS.
10. Please affix own Price tag or Not for Sale tag, on front of painting.
