Exhibits to be in the Pavilion by 9 am Thursday 7th March 2024 please enter through back door.

1. All exhibits to be grown by exhibitor. Grain exhibits to be marked on bottom of bags with owner's private mark to ensure identification at close of show.
2. All grain must be of current seasons growth, free from weevils and must be of specified weight.
3. The stewards reserve the right to reject any grain showing weevils, also exhibits of insufficient weight or size. All exhibits to be chemical free.
4. Points for special trophies to be allocated 2 points for first, 1 point for second.
5. Wheat to be judged on the following scale of points: Condition 60 (made up as follows: colour 15, plumpness of grain 15, freedom from foreign matter 15, trueness of type 15); Freedom from Mottle 20 points, weight 20 points (2 points to be allowed for every kilogram per HL over 74 kg per HL); Total 100

Prize money can be collected from the Secretary Office on Saturday between 2pm – 5 pm

Exhibits may be collected between 6pm – 6.30pm Saturday 9th March 2024, or Sunday 10th March 2024 between 7.30 am – 9 am. Collection must be checked with stewards before removing.

Exhibits not picked up by 9 am Sunday morning will be disposed of unless other arrangements are made with the Chief Steward.
