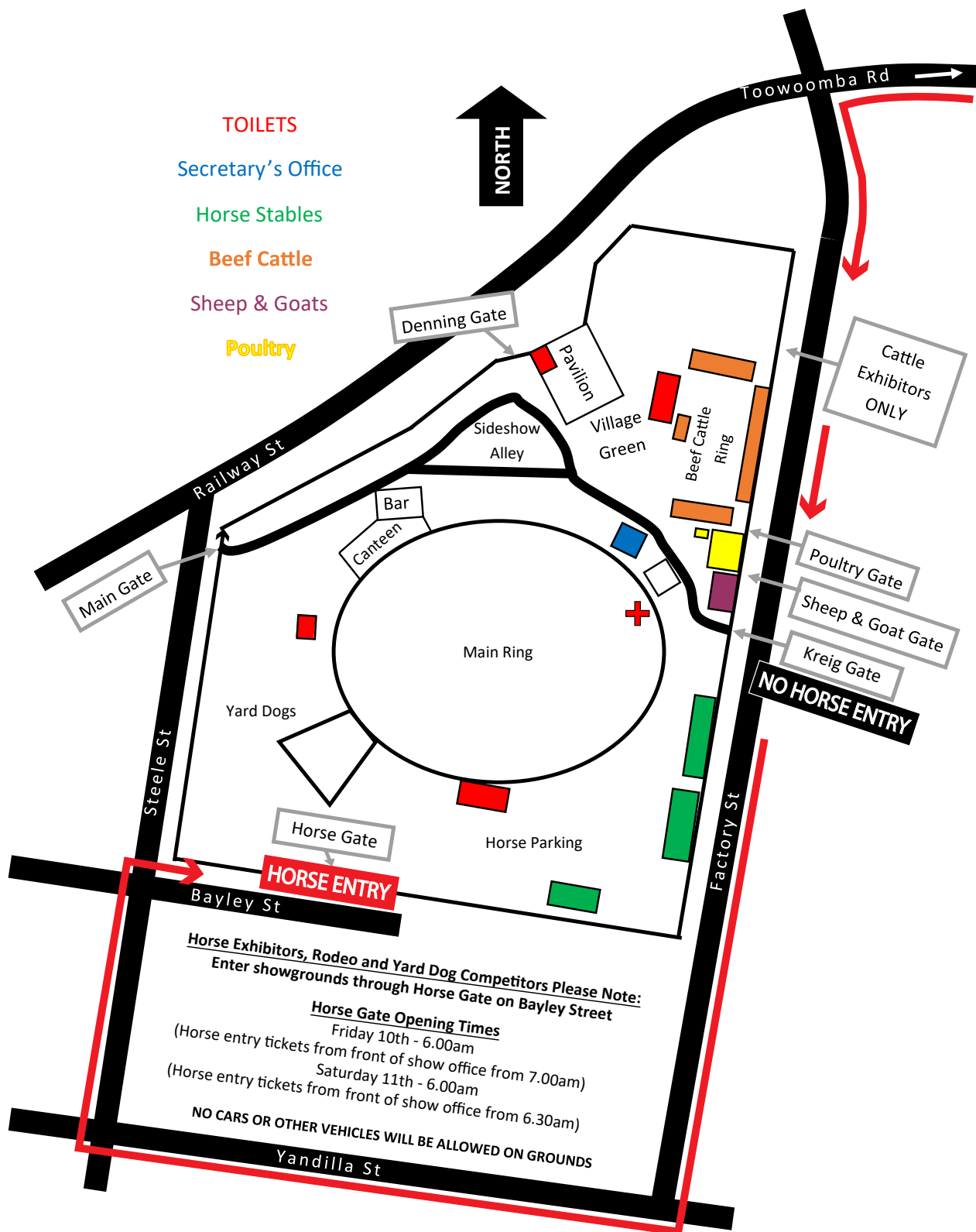

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLETE THE INDEMNITY FORM, AND PAY ADMISSION TO THE SHOW

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per class

Prizes: First \$15 Second \$8 Third \$4 (unless otherwise stated)

Conditions:

1. Lambs are to be **penned by 11:00AM FRIDAY 7TH MARCH.**
2. Judging to commence: **11:00AM FRIDAY 7TH MARCH.**
3. Auction Sale to commence at **4pm FRIDAY 7TH MARCH.**
4. Unloading ramp next to the poultry pavilion
5. Please unload, park and enter and pay at the Krieg Gate, Factory Street
6. In the event of any entry having been, in the opinion of the Judge, entered in the wrong class, they shall instruct the Stewards to transfer them to the proper class.
7. All Lambs are to be offered by auction. A \$4.00 fee will be charged on any lots passed in.
8. Exhibits in this section may be removed after the sale.
9. For Champion prizes, all first prize winners of each class to compete. After selecting the Champion, the Judge will be required to select the Reserve Champion. The Reserve Champion shall be selected from the remaining first prize winners together with the second prizewinner of the class, which furnished the Champion. Reserve ribbons to be awarded at Judge's discretion.

ALL LAMBS TO BE WEIGHED ON ARRIVAL BY STEWARDS.

Class 5001 - PEN OF 3 LAMBS. Average live weight 40 - 45kg.

Class 5002 - PEN OF 3 LAMBS. Average live weight over 45.1 to 50kg.

Class 5003 - PEN OF 3 LAMBS. The average live weight 50.1kg to 55kg

Class 5004 - PEN OF 3 LAMBS. The average live weight 55.1kg to 60 kg

Class 5005 - PEN OF 3 LAMBS. The average live weight 60.1 and over.
