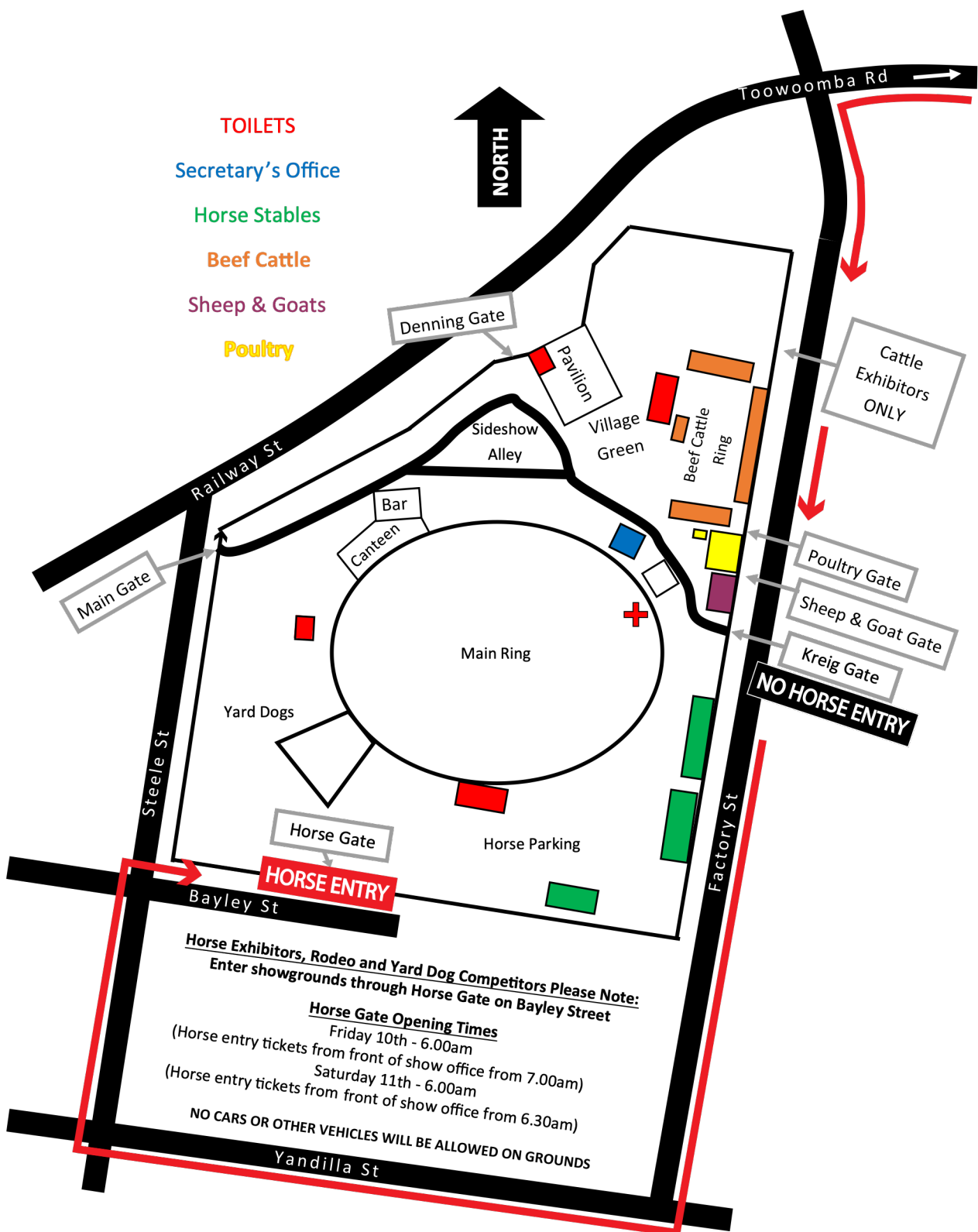

Cattle Conditions of entry

1. General Conditions

- Cattle Entries: All cattle entries close **Friday, 27th February at 4pm.**
- **2026 Judging Format:** Judging for 2026 will be conducted as **European, British, Small Breeds, and Tropical**, rather than individual breeds.
- **Cattle Departure:** Cattle may not leave the showgrounds until after the completion of the Led Steer Judging, which is approximately at 2pm. The **Loading Ramp Gates** will be locked until judging is completed.
- **Entry Gate:** The entry gate located on **Factory Street** (main entry to Cattle section) will be manned:

Friday from 10am

Saturday from 5:30am

- A **one-day entry fee** will be charged, and a **two-day pass** will be provided to cattle exhibitors arriving on Friday. All admission fees must be paid in cash at the gate upon entry. Parking will be available for all vehicles on the grounds for camping.
- **Prize Money:** Prize money will be available **after the completion** of Led Steer Judging from the Prize Money Office. **NOTHING PRIOR WILL BE HANDED OUT.**

2. Eligibility

- All cattle are eligible, except those from restricted or quarantined herds.
- All cattle must comply with current NLIS regulations. The Pittsworth Show Society Inc. will read NLIS devices on **Saturday, 7th March 2026**, before judging begins. The Pittsworth Showgrounds **PIC is: QEPW0235**. An Owner Waybill and Health Declaration must accompany all cattle.
- The age of all cattle shall be the actual age as of **1st March 2026**.
- All animals **MUST** be registered in a herd or calf register of the respective Breed Society and **MUST** be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. Checks of Breed Society registers will be conducted if necessary.

3. Identification

- All animals **MUST** have a brand, either tattoo or fire, and NLIS tag **MUST** be in all animals.

4. Health & Fitness

- Any animals deemed unfit for exhibition by the stewards may be rejected and barred from competition. Such animals must be removed from the grounds immediately upon notification to the exhibitor.

5. Judging

- Judges may withhold prizes if an exhibit in any class or championship is deemed unworthy.
- The maximum age for a calf shown as a calf at foot is **9 months**. Calves at foot may not be shown in a separate class but may compete in the **2026 Junior Bull Spectacular** if under 9 months.

6. Disputes

1. Any disputes must be submitted in writing and handed to the Recording Stewards within **30 minutes** of the incident, accompanied by a **\$50 bond, refundable only if the dispute is upheld.**

7. Entry Fees & Alterations

- No refunds of entry fees will be given, except in exceptional circumstances, which may be considered within seven days of the show.
- Alterations to entries must be submitted to the Chief Recorder no later than **7:00 AM on Saturday.**

8. Handling & Control

- All cattle aged **9 months or over** must have appropriate nose grips or rings.
- All stock **MUST** be under the control of the exhibitor or their representative at all times.
- It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that leaders in judging rings and parades can maintain control over their animals.

9. Insurance & Equipment

- All exhibitors must have Public Liability Insurance endorsed for travel to shows.
- Electrical equipment brought to the Showgrounds must have residual current protection, and all leads, tools, and appliances must be inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and tagged. Double adapters are prohibited, and all power boards must be tested and tagged. Clipping crates may only be placed on the grounds with approval from the Cattle Committee.

10. Showground Rules

- Driving on the ring area is strictly prohibited.
- Alcohol may only be consumed within designated liquor-permitted areas (e.g., the Bar).
- The Pittsworth Showgrounds has a strict **NO DOGS ALLOWED** policy unless the dogs are part of a competition.

11. Supervision & Departure

- Exhibitors aged under 16 years **MUST** have a supervisor present at all times and must sign the attached waiver.
- Cattle may not leave the showgrounds until after the completion of Led Steer Judging at approximately **2:00 PM**. Loading ramp gates will remain locked until judging is completed.
