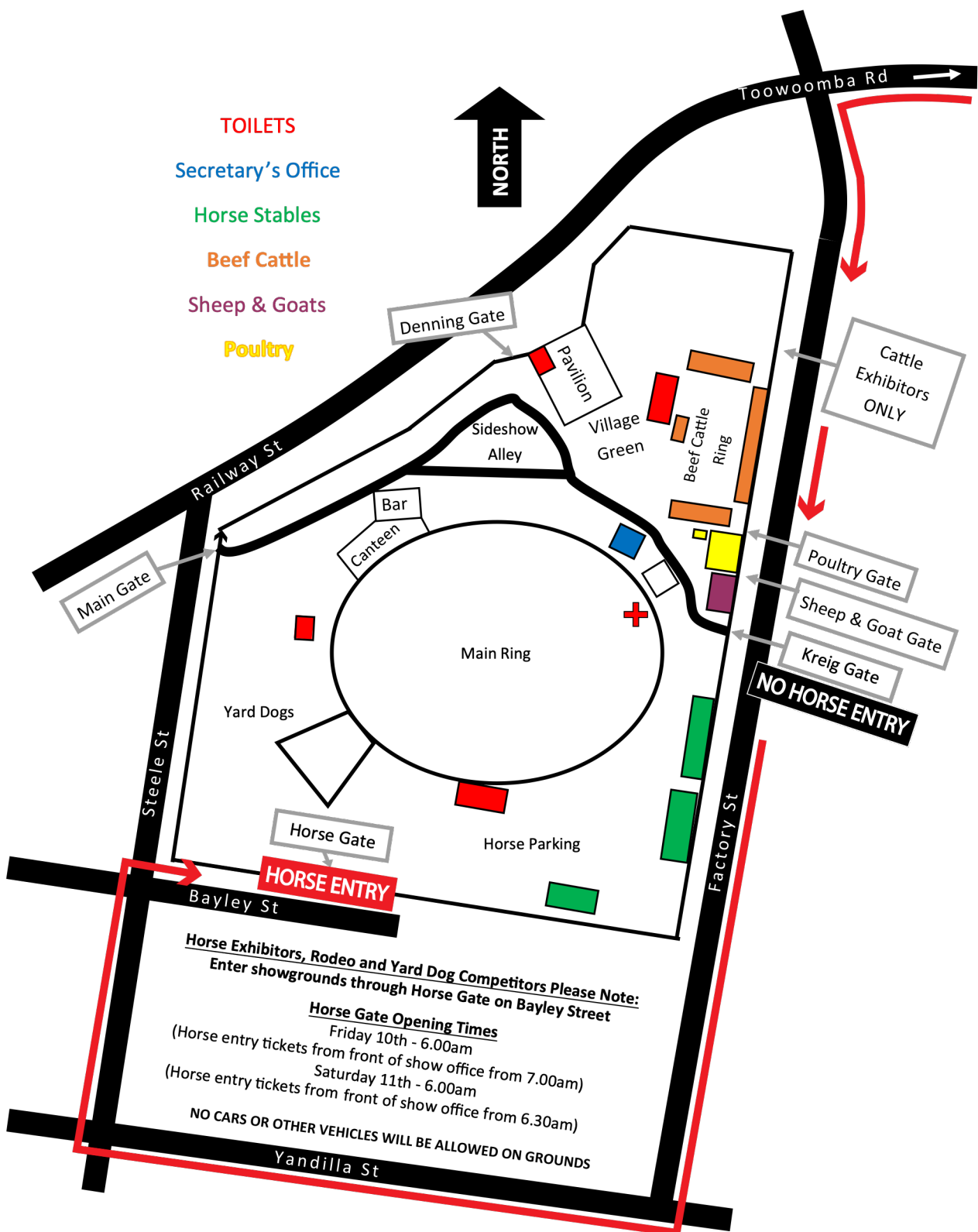

ALL EXHIBITORS MUST COMPLETE THE INDEMNITY FORM, AND PAY ADMISSION TO THE SHOW

Entry Fee: \$5.00 per class

Prizes: First \$15 Second \$8 Third \$4 (unless otherwise stated)

Conditions:

1. Lambs are to be **penned by 11:00AM FRIDAY 6TH MARCH.**
2. Judging to commence: **11:00AM FRIDAY 6TH MARCH.**
3. Auction Sale to commence at **4pm FRIDAY 6TH MARCH.**
4. Unloading ramp next to the poultry pavilion
5. Please unload, park and enter and pay at the Krieg Gate, Factory Street
6. In the event of any entry having been, in the opinion of the Judge, entered in the wrong class, they shall instruct the Stewards to transfer them to the proper class.
7. All Lambs are to be offered by auction. A \$4.00 fee will be charged on any lots passed in.
8. Exhibits in this section may be removed after the sale.
9. For Champion prizes, all first prize winners of each class to compete. After selecting the Champion, the Judge will be required to select the Reserve Champion. The Reserve Champion shall be selected from the remaining first prize winners together with the second prize winner of the class, which furnished the Champion. Reserve ribbons to be awarded at Judge's discretion.

POINTS TROPHY

Trophy for the exhibitor gaining the greatest number of points in the Prime Lamb classes. Points allotted: First 5, Second 2 points each class. In the event of a tie, the Champion and Reserve Champion prize will be taken into consideration and if still not resolved, the judge of the section, in consultation with the Stewards of the Prime Lamb section, is empowered to arrive at a method of selecting the winning exhibitor.
