 - Fees are payable at the Show Office (cash and EFTPOS available) **by 10AM Tuesday 3rd March. Exhibitor tags will be given at this time.**
 - Manual entries will be accommodated at the Show Office, and will close at 4PM Monday, 2nd March. **No late entries will be accepted.**
 - Exhibits can be delivered to the Show Office between Monday 23rd February and Monday 2nd March.
 - Refer to each section for specific entry fees and specific delivery dates for your exhibits.
- **Exhibit Delivery to Pavilion (Wednesday, 4th March)**
 - Art exhibits must be delivered by **10:00 AM**.
 - Needlework, Handicraft, Photography, and Pot Plants must be delivered by **3:00 PM**.

Method –

1. Approximately 6weeks prior to the show Sprinkle some grass seeds into the bottom of the stocking foot and fill it with potting mix or sphagnum moss.
2. Twist stocking into shape and size of tennis ball, tie it off leaving about 10cm dangling down at the bottom.
3. Use an elastic band to make a bulging nose in the stocking face.
4. Give your grass head a goofy face, glue on googly eyes, pipe cleaners for eyebrows and any decorations you like.
5. Half fill a small container (eg yoghurt container) with water and place the head on top, so the stocking tail is dangling into the water.
6. Use a spray bottle of water to moisten head.
7. Place on a windowsill that gets plenty of sun. use spray bottle daily to keep moist.
