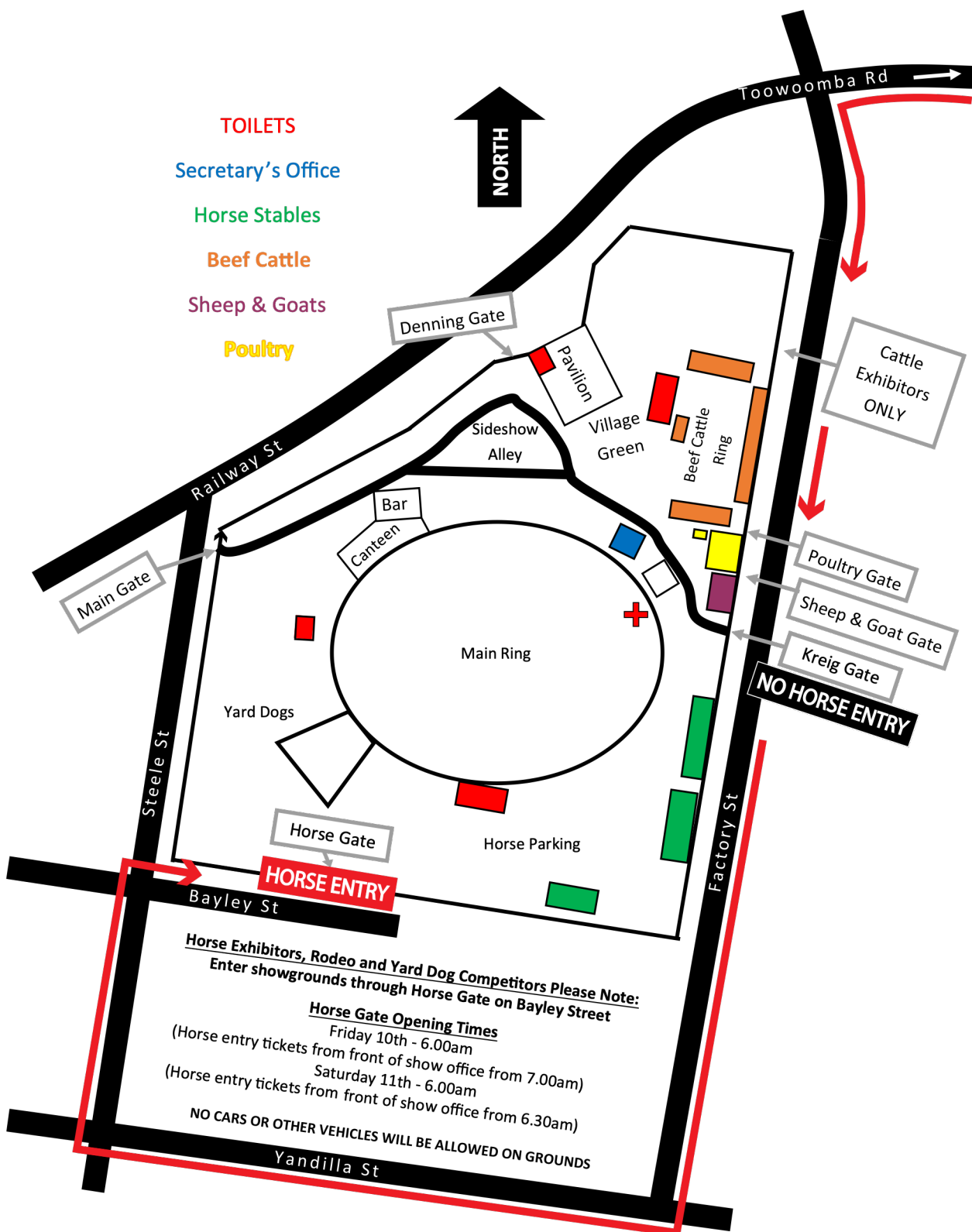

4. Please unload, park and enter and pay at the Krieg Gate, Factory Street
5. The Stewards have the right to reject any sheep or place them in a different class.
6. All stock to be from brucellosis accredited flock. A Brucellosis certificate will be requested on arrival.
7. All exhibitors to be registered with their respective breed society.
8. OJD accredited studs will also be accommodated.
